## KING'S CORONATION

Our theme for May is the King's Coronation. The King's Coronation will take place on the 6th of May 2023, at Westminster Abbey.

### Do you know what a Coronation is?

This is a ceremony where a new King or Queen gets 'crowned' and is given Royal Power. The last coronation took place in 1953 for Queen Elizabeth II. 70 years ago! This was the first Royal Coronation to be watched and listened to live, over the radio and television. Over 20 million people (about the population of New York) tuned in to watch/listen to this!

The new monarch (the King) is given special robes and objects which symbolise their promise to protect their people and be a fair ruler. They are anointed (smeared) with holy oil and most importantly, a royal crown is placed upon their head.

# RECIPE of the Month



## Chicken Tikka Masala

This dish costs less than £5 to make!

### INGREDIENTS

**60g** Brown Rice  
**120ml** Water  
**25ml** Rapeseed Oil  
**320g** Diced Chicken Breast  
**100g** Spanish Onion  
**50g** Red Pepper  
**4g** Garlic Puree  
**200g** Tomato Based Sauce/Chopped Tomatoes  
**4g** Ground Ginger  
**4g** Garam Masala Spice

To make this dish vegetarian, swap the chicken breast with 85g Cauliflower, 150g Chick Peas and 85g Carrots.

SERVES 4



### METHOD

#### CHICKEN TIKKA

Heat the oil in a pan. Add the chopped onion and cook until soft and golden. Add the Garam Masala, ground ginger, sliced peppers and garlic puree, cook for 5 minutes. Add the diced chicken breast and cook for 2 minutes. Add the tomato sauce, cover and simmer gently for 15 mins until the chicken temperature reaches +82C.

#### RICE

Measure out the rice using a cup and put it into a pot. Pour in double the quantity of water and cover with a lid. Steam on a gentle heat for 30 minutes, remove lid and stir. Cool slightly and serve.
