Attendance Poster Competition

Here at the South Hams Federation schools, we want to work with both our pupils and their parents to do our best to prevent poor attendance from hampering attainment and development of social skills. We want to instil a positive attitude to school attendance as early as possible to ensure that all of our pupils go on to thrive throughout their school and future careers.

In every other aspect of life, if someone achieved 90% of their goal, they would be celebrating! However, when it comes to school attendance, a percentage of 90% can leave a child falling behind their peers in their education. 90% is the equivalent of almost 4 weeks of school missed in an academic year.

Good attendance not only gives a child a better education, but also encourages positive social interactions. Children get to spend time with their friends, which in turn improves their social skills. It also provides a routine and safe space for children who really need this.

We would like all our children to take part in a competition to design the best poster to promote attendance and prompt arrival. Poster designs will need to be A4 in size and will need to clearly promote the importance of regular school attendance. Posters could include attendance slogans, drawn images or fun facts. The posters will need to be visually appealing, clear and concise.

Winners will be selected from each year group across the federation and will each receive a goody bag including a book, stationery and a fidget toy. Posters will be used to promote attendance across all our schools, in classrooms, on our websites and in our newsletters.

Please clearly put your child's name and Year group on the back of the poster.

The competition will close on 17th November.

Winners will be announced via a federation assembly online on the 24th November.

Mr. Branch also was very impressed with the refreshingly positive mindset the girls had towards the tournament, getting comments from other coaches and teams with how well the girls approached the games.

- Looking at other artists work and making artworks which have been inspired by them (including the artists Chiaozza and the children made wonderful abstract papier mache cacti)
- Printmaking using gelli pads
- Printmaking using empty tetra packs
- Dice-Rolling Abstract art game to produce beautiful abstract artwork
- Rolled and stamped clay decorations
- Mini theatres complete with scenery and characters
- Stitching their own monster 'softie' dolls
- Mixed media funky decorated spectacles
- Clay animals
- Clay succulent pots
- Inventing a new mythological beast and creating it in collage

It will run on Thursday afternoons from 3:40 - 4:55. The club will start on 14th September it will run up to and including 12th October for the first half term in Autumn. The second half term will run from 2nd November until 14th December. The price is £8 and this cost includes all materials, any kiln firing costs etc. This will be payable via Payment Pay. Children are required to sign up for a full term. The club is open to Key Stage Two children and there will be 12 spaces available.

Children must bring their own protective clothing as we will be using paints, inks etc which won't necessarily wash out of clothing!


- Christmas lights resources




