As Geographers we are learning about the journey of food. We will be considering where our food comes from, how our food gets to us and the different people involved in the production of food.

As Historians we are learning about our local place and how it has changed. We will consider and research how and why our local area has changed.

In Art our enquiry question is 'how can we transform an object and turn it into a sculpture, using our imagination'. We will be using a variety of materials to explore the craft of traditional worry dolls.

In Computing we will be creating media. In this unit, pupils will be using a computer to create music. They will listen to a variety of pieces of music and consider how music can make them think and feel.

In PSHE our focus is health and wellbeing. We will be learning about physical health and mental wellbeing, growing and changing and keeping safe.

As Scientists our new unit is plants, we will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will also find out how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

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In our English we are beginning with the fictional text 'Mixed up Fairy tales'. Throughout this unit we will be learning how to use compound sentences in our writing, the use of expanded noun phrases for description and using past tense verbs.

In spellings we are continuing to learn different rules following Little Wandle. Throughout this unit, we will be recapping familiar graphemes whilst exploring different ways of spelling words. We will also be learning about different rules within spelling such as how the endings or words change, syllables within words and double letters. As Mathematicians we will begin with a unit on addition and subtraction of two-digit numbers. We will also be covering money, fractions, time and position and direction.

As Musicians we will be learning how to play the recorder. We will learn about rhythm and the importance of timing. Children will work together, listen to each other and play in time.

In RE, we will be learning about Judaism and exploring some traditional stories within the religion.

In PE we will begin with 'Attack versus defence'. This unit of work will challenge pupils to create simple attacking and defending tactics. Pupils will apply these tactics as a team into games. We will also be using the swimming pool further into the Summer Term.

As Design Technologists we will be using templates and joining techniques to change a 2D shape to a 3D product.
