Dinner Money Debt

Dear Parents/Carers,

Can you please ensure that all school dinners are paid for in advance and any current debt on your child's account is cleared as quickly as possible? Debt letters are sent out weekly and you can also check your child's balance online. You can set up a low balance alert on your account to notify you to top up when you reach the limit set. If you are struggling to pay off your debt, please contact the school to arrange an appointment to discuss payment options.

Year 5- ICC Visit

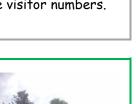
Year 5 are invited to visit ICC on Tuesday 21st June

For both posts you will:

Be supportive, patient, resilient, friendly, enthusiastic, motivated and creative and be willing to assist with the personal needs of the pupil as well

[] Work under the direction of the class teachers, SENDCO and school leaders to lead and organise activities for the pupil

I Support the child to be included in all aspects of the school, through modelling and remodelling of language used by others

Develop and reinforce key vocabulary through regular pre and post teaching

Act as an important communication link between home and school

Support the specific learning needs of the pupil so that they can access the curriculum and socialise with their peers

Previous experience of working with children and young people with a hearing impairment is an advantage.
