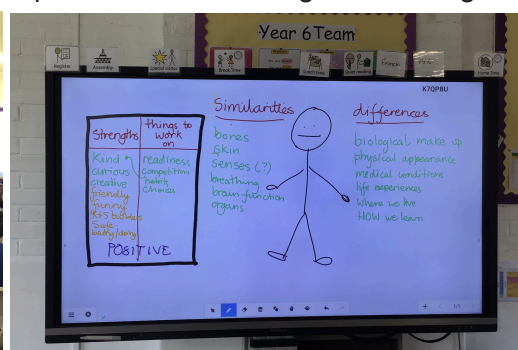
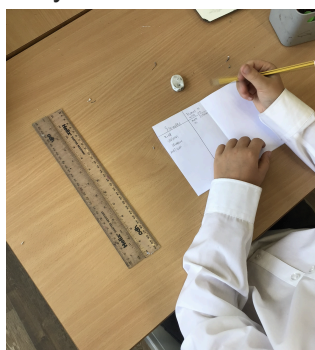
Let's make this year one of kindness, collaboration, and success. Together, we can create a positive and supportive environment where everyone feels valued and empowered to thrive.

Here's to a fantastic start and an incredible year ahead!

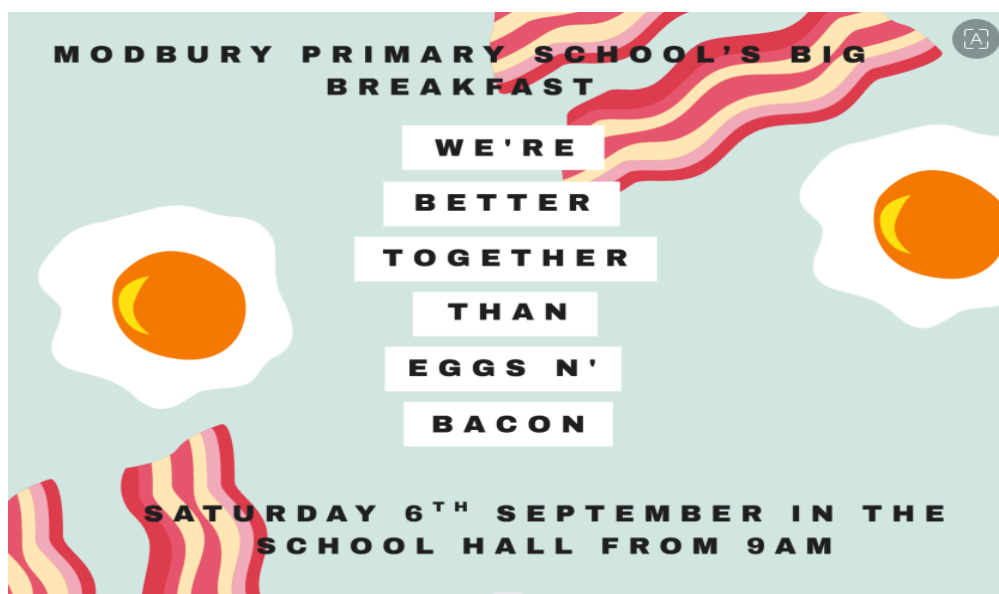

School Meals and Universal Infant Free School Meals

Please ensure school meals are paid in advance via Bromcom. Meals can be ordered a week in advance for your child via the app. The price of a school meal from the 1st September 2025 is now:

If you experience any difficulties ordering or booking meals please contact the School Office. If you feel that your child may be entitled to Free School Meals, due to your financial circumstances, please contact Devon County Council either by phone on 0345 155 1019 or by visiting their website portal at: https://oneonline.devon.gov.uk/CCSCitizenPortal_LIVE

If your child has moved up from Year 2 to Year 3, please note you will no longer qualify for Universal Infant free School Meals and will now need to pay for your child's meals, unless your child is entitled to Free School Meals as detailed above.

Privacy Notices

Schools collect, store, process, share and dispose of lots of personal information relating to pupils, parents, governors, employees and visitors. Data Collection Information

At school we have an electronic pupil information system where we record important information about your child's personal details, such as; contacts and their details, medical and dietary details, and any other important information supplied by parents and carers. As we are now using Bromcom, parents are able to check that the information we hold is correct and up to date via the MCAS app. If you would like a paper copy of your child's data collection form then please contact the school office who will be able to arrange this for you to update. It is vitally important that this information is up to date for every child in school and particularly with regard to any contact or medical information the school needs to be aware of.

Medications in School

If your child requires medication administered in school, please remember to fill out a green form. We will be sending out email reminders two weeks before the expiry date of all medication so that it is replaced in time. Thank you for your help and, if you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact the School Office.

Agreements/Consent Forms

During the course of your child's education, all parents and carers complete a KS1 and a KS2 Agreement pack which contains consent for your child for local school visits, photos, video, audio and communication. If you wish to update/opt out of any of your child's consent information, then please contact the school office in the first instance. You can request for this information to be updated or can opt in/out at any time during the academic year.
