Friday 15th July	All dinner money debts must be paid by today. Please pay online of SCOPay or by cash or cheque payable to DCC. Please take into account and pay in advance for any school dinners your child may have next week. School dinners orders required for next week must also be pre-booked - please inform the School Administrator or your class teacher of your requirements.
w/c Mon 18th July	Activation emails/letters will be sent to parents in order to set up their Parent Pay accounts. We ask that parents to credit their ParentPay accounts with a minimum of £5 for any dinners to be taken w/c 5 th September. Any balances on SCOPay accounts will be transferred this week to Parent Pay.
Tuesday 19th July	Online SCOPay dinner payments will stop from today
Monday 5th Sept	Parent Pay goes "live" for School payments
